



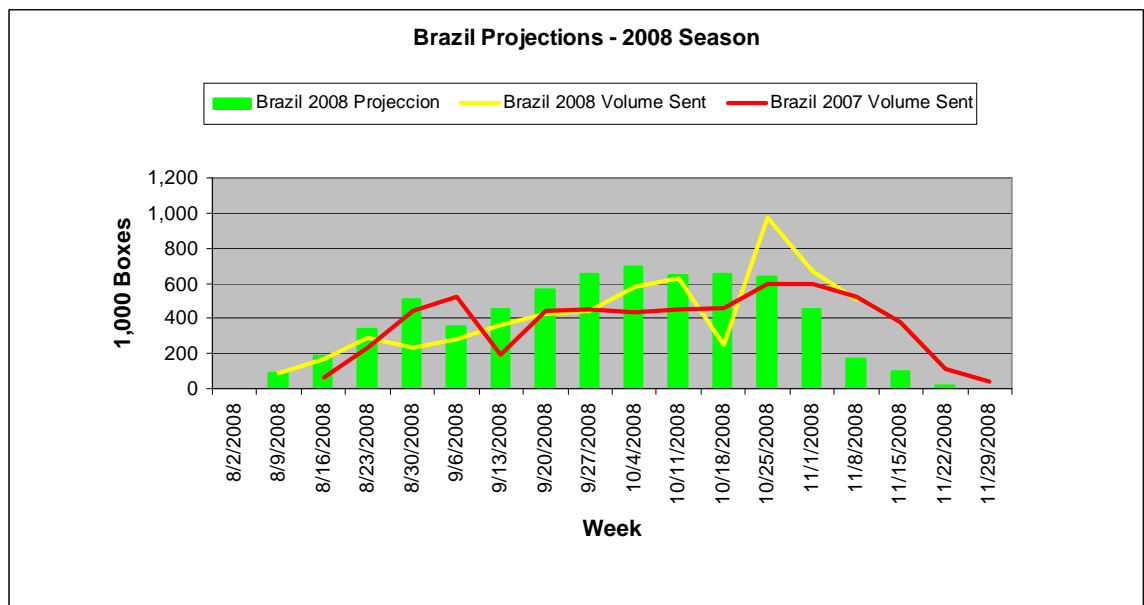
# Mango Crop Forecast - Updated November 13, 2008

*The Crop Forecast is updated regularly and can be found at [mango.org](http://mango.org), Retailer Section.*

The National Mango Board is working with the organizations in the mango-producing countries to get projections of what will be shipped to the U.S. this season. This document will be updated as we receive new information from each country.

**Brazil:** Brazil's projection has been adjusted. According to the volume sent and the projections for the rest of the season, the total volume will be approximately 6.0 million boxes. Please see the projection and remember these are shipping weeks.

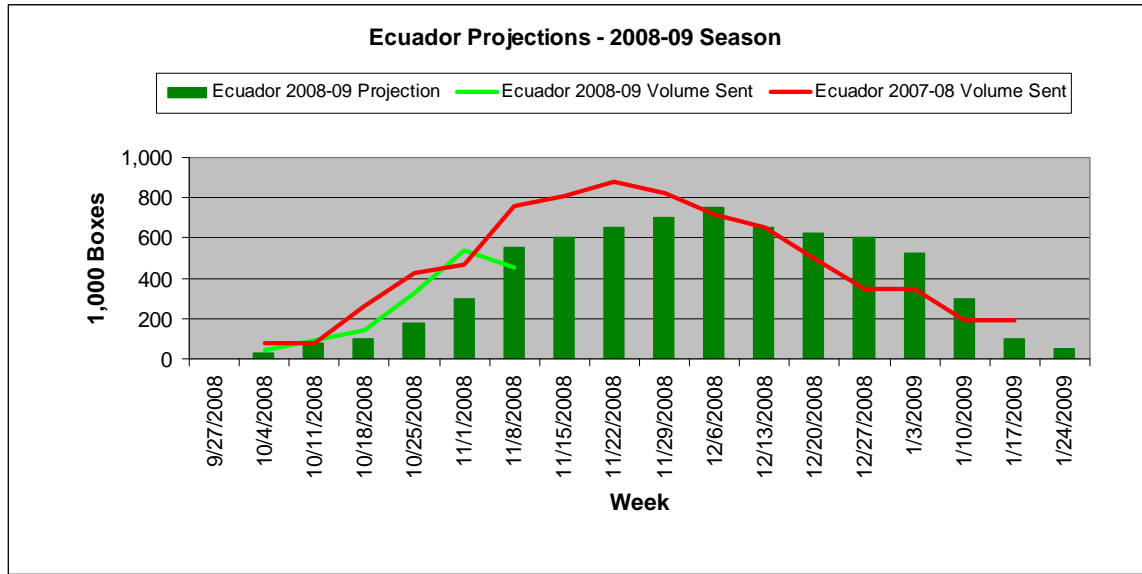

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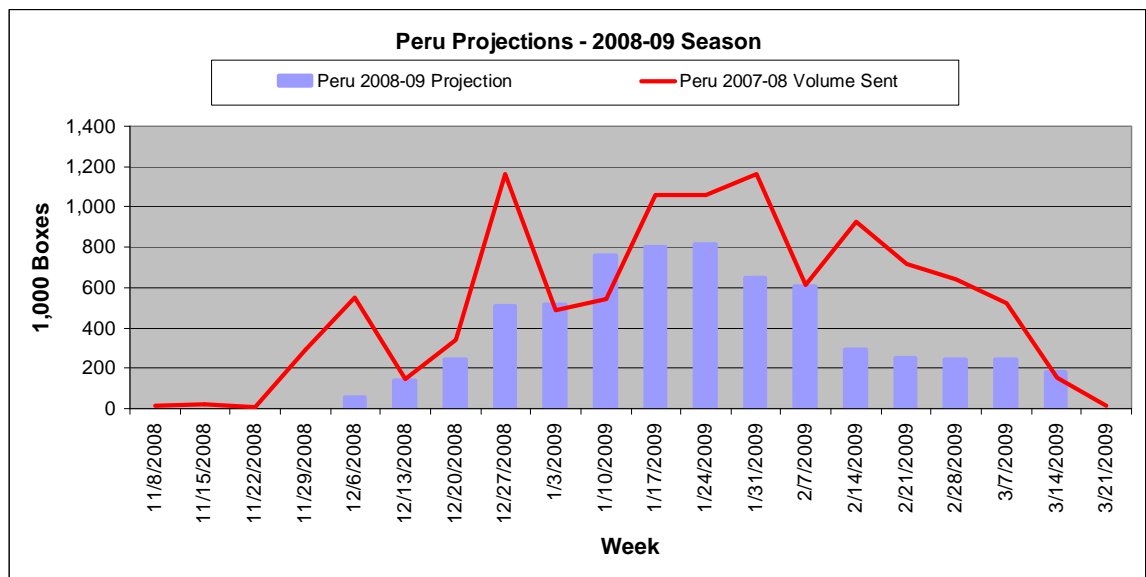

**Ecuador:** Ecuador’s shipments started the beginning of October and the season is expected to end in January of 2009. According to the projections provided by La Fundacion Mango del Ecuador (FMDE) the volume for this season will be approximately of 6.8 million boxes. The peak of the season will be at the end of November, beginning of December. The projection will be adjusted throughout the season.



**Mango Import Projection & Volume Sent—Peru**

**Peru:** Projections indicate Peru’s season will start approximately the second week of December with an estimated volume of approximately 6.3 million boxes. Peru’s projections will be adjusted throughout the season.

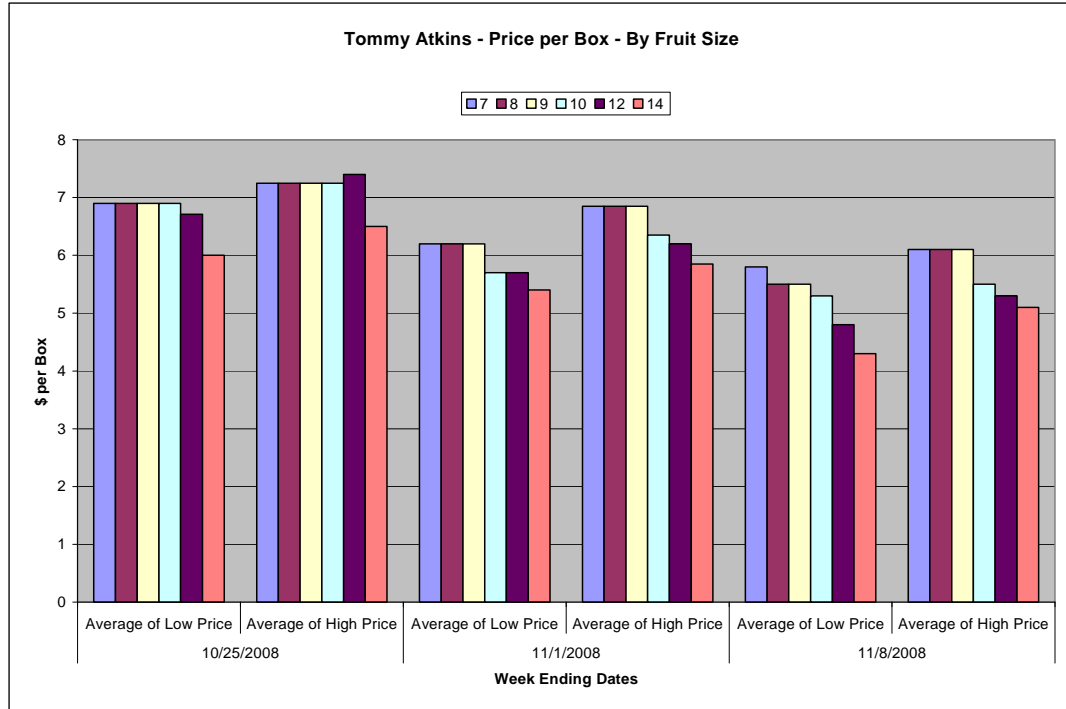
